

JOHN C. BURGNER HIS BOOK

The above title was found on the inside cover of an account book, the property of the Haywood County Historical Society, Waynesville, N.C., a copy of which follows. Letters from that Society, regarding use of this manuscript, and a summary of its contents follow the manuscript copy.

Page numbers at the bottom of each page are assigned to facilitate keeping the book in order.

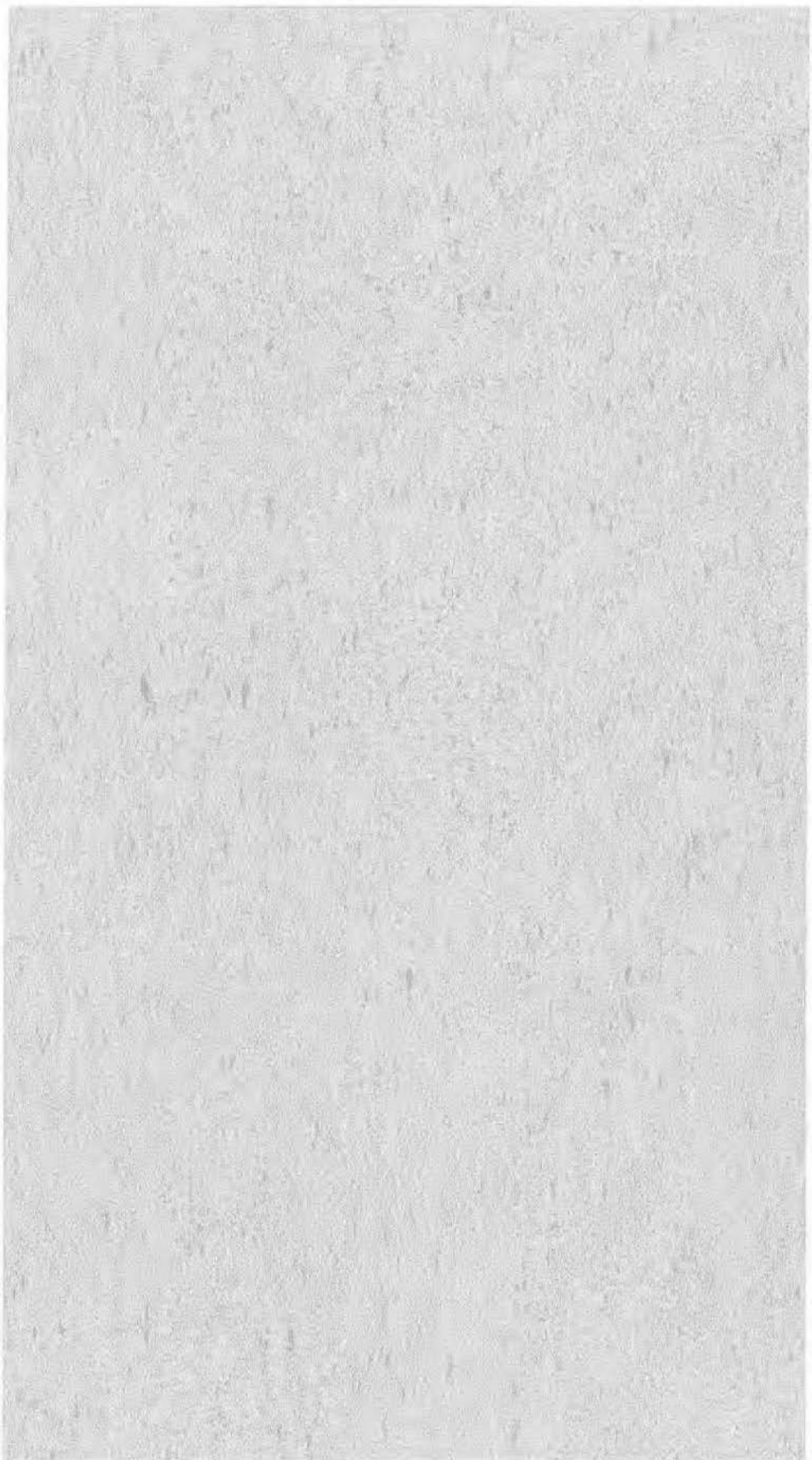
Cabinetmaker Burgner began his daily account of work done, in a simple list form, at the back page and progressed forward. His customer accounts, in double bookkeeping fashion, start with the first page and progress in the usual fashion.

The center pages of the book were not used for Burgner's accounts. Except for idle scribblings only one page had any notations:
